



Time Period: 7/1/2017 to 6/30/2022





Information About Risk: Equity Securities Risk. Since the Select Fund invests in equity securities, it is subject to the risk that stock prices will fall over short or extended periods of time. Historically, the equity markets have moved in cycles, and the value of the Select Fund's equity securities may fluctuate from day to day. Individual companies may report poor results or be negatively affected by industry and/or economic trends and developments. The prices of securities issued by such companies may suffer a decline in response. These factors contribute to price volatility, which is a principal risk of investing in the Select Fund. **Market Risk.** The value of securities in the Select Fund's portfolio will fluctuate and, as a result, the Select Fund's share price may decline suddenly or over a sustained period. The equity securities purchased by the Select Fund may involve large price swings and potential for loss. **Management Risk.** The strategies used by the Adviser may fail to produce the intended result. **Large Cap Risk.** Larger, more established companies may be unable to attain the high growth rates of successful, smaller companies during periods of economic expansion. **Risks of Investment Selection and Asset Allocation.** The Select Fund's investment success depends on the skill of the Adviser in evaluating, selecting and monitoring the portfolio assets. 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Key Definitions:

Index - Morningstar Large-Mid Cap Value - The index provides a comprehensive depiction of the performance and fundamental characteristics of the Large-Mid Cap Value segment of U.S. equity markets. TR indicates "Total Return". **Index - Russell 1000 Value** - Market-capitalization weighted index of those firms in the Russell 1000 with lower price-to-book ratios and lower forecasted growth values. TR indicates "Total Return". **Index - S&P 500** - A market capitalization-weighted index of 500 widely held stocks often used as a proxy for the stock market TR indicates "Total Return". **Active share.** The fraction of a fund's portfolio holdings that deviate from the benchmark index. The active share of a mutual fund ranges from zero (pure index fund) to 100% (no overlap with the benchmark). **Upside Capture Ratio** - measures a manager's performance in up markets relative to the market (benchmark) itself. It is calculated by taking the security's upside capture return and dividing it by the benchmark's upside capture return. **Downside Capture Ratio** - Downside Capture Ratio measures manager's performance in down markets. A down-market is defined as those periods (months or quarters) in which market return is less than 0. In essence, it tells you what percentage of the down-market was captured by the manager. For example, if the ratio is 110%, the ma
